TEAMLINE® 1-800-846-4700

TEAMLINE is used by the parents and relatives of players and displaced or traveling sports fans who are unable to hear their favorite team's games on local radio or television. Games are transmitted LIVE from each team's flagship radio station. TEAMLINE provides live coverage for over 500 college and professional sports teams.

Calls to TEAMLINE are charged to your MasterCard/Visa at a rate of between 50¢ and 20¢ per minute depending on the length of the call. If you purchase a TEAMLINE Telephone Season Ticket you can pay as little as 20¢ for every minute - call our customer service number at 1-800-225-5321 for details. You can call from any phone - home, office, car, hotel, even a pay phone, from anywhere in the U.S. Canadian and International callers can direct dial 330-374-6300.

To use TEAMLINE just dial 1-800-846-4700 and enter your team's four-digit code and your VISA or MasterCard number when prompted. You are then connected to the live play-by-play. Call in on game day to listen to the pre-game show, the live broadcast or the post-game show. Call in during the week to hear the coach's show or to access your team's voice mailbox. The team code can be used for football, basketball and any other sport your team chooses to broadcast on TEAMLINE. A portion of all revenue generated by TEAMLINE is paid to the team you call.
