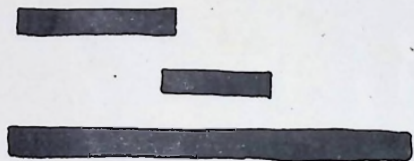

From The Director



The job of putting together a show—the preparation and planning even before rehearsals start—is tremendous. To prepare a musical requires ant-like persistence. The show is never out of your mind from the moment you put pencil to paper until the sets are struck closing night.

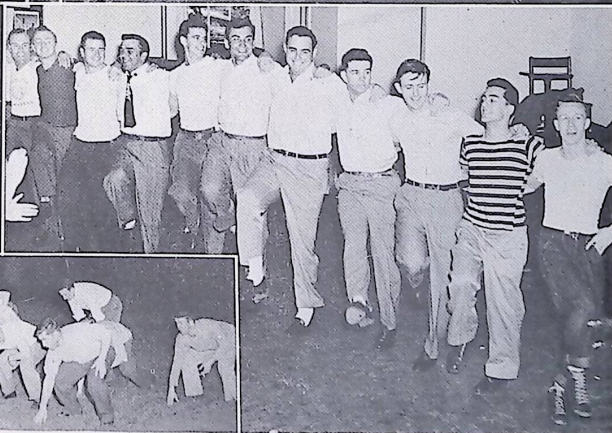
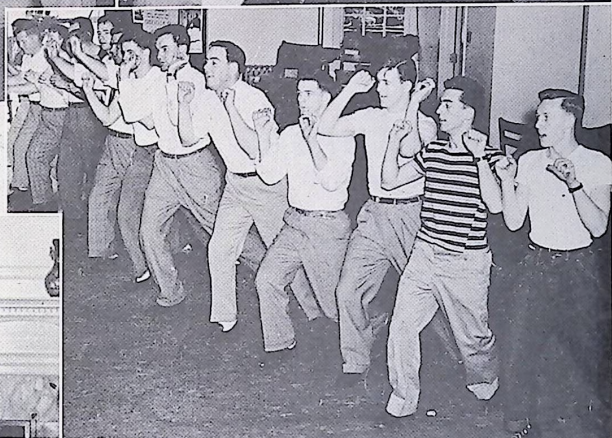
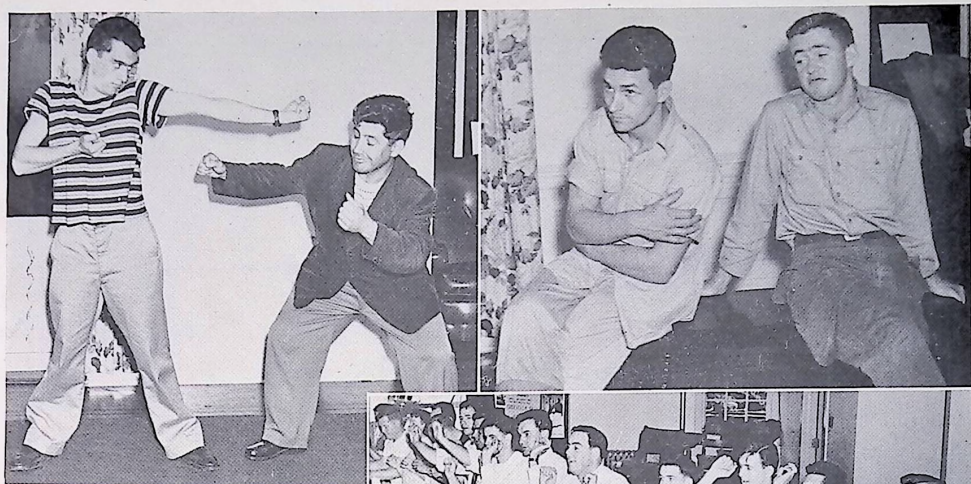


GEORGE F. RALSTON

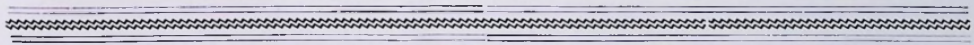
