All eyes will be on senior captain Herb Kemp as the four year veteran prepares to close out a glorious career. With eleven games left to play the Glenside, Pa. ace has accumulated 1096 points and 993 rebounds, the fourth and first highest totals respectively in Wilkes Basketball History.

The Swimming team, -0-3 thus far, should also break into the win column with gamer foes scheduled for the coming half. Coach Bob Corba's forces had to contend with Pennsylvania swimming powers East Stroudsburg and Bloomsburg during the first half.

Dear Bob

Enclosed herewith it is complete information on the "middle atlantics" as far as the sport of wrestling is concerned. I am sure this is the first time anyone has ever put all of this together and I base my confidence on the extreme difficulty I encountered trying to collect all of it. You doubtless are aware that 2 separate organizations called "The Middle Atlantic..." are involved. The predecessor to the present organization (which took over in 1957) was called "The Middle Atlantic Collegiate Wrestling Association" and was formed March 30, 1935 when representatives from Gettysburg, Haverford, Lafayette, and Ursinus agreed to meet the following spring in a wrestling tournament. They conducted a meet every year thereafter except '44, '45, and '46, and as such provided a focal point for collegiate wrestling teams who were NOT members of the Easterns. Rutgers, Muhlenberg, Swarthmore, Bucknell, and Delaware later became members of the group in that order until 1949 when Rutgers elected to go into the Easterns. After this, no new members were taken into the 8-team group; I know for a fact that West Chester tried to get in and was turned down. Then the present body, the M.A.S.C.A., took over, but the meet was still called "the Middle Atlantics" and the records of the older group were more or less retained.

The attaching listings are as correct as any human can make them and represent many hours of research at Lafayette and Gettysburg, as well as plenty of help from your old boss Ace Bailey. You will note one major correction of an error which has appeared on recent programs: Rutgers was champion in 1948, not host.

I hope you receive this in time to make use of it in your 1970 program.

You know, Bob, 1969 was really the year the Middle Atlantics "arrived". Wayne Boyd was the first man from the Conference who won a NCAA University Div. title; and of course, Wiendl repeated; Willigan went on to win the World Deaf Games title, Pruzansky the Maccabiah title; the team showing by Temple, Hofstra, and Wilkes was the highest team placings by M.A. teams in the Nationals ever; and for the first time, wrestlers from M.A. teams made up the largest part of the "East" squad in the E-W Dual.

In the 3-page list of individual champions, you will note the first two pages are arranged in 8 vertical columns, while the last page lists each of the 9 winners for the last few years. I didn't put weight classes at the top of the columns because they changed so much, but for the record, the 8 weight classes used up until 1966 were as follows: "

1936 & 1937 - 115,125,135,145,155,165,175,Unl.
1938 - 118,126,135,145,155,165,175,Unl.
1939 - 1950 - 121,128,136,145,155,165,175,Unl.
1951- 1965 - 123,130,137,147,157,167,177,Unl. "

CAGEMEN FINISH SUCCESSFUL

The Wilkes College Cage Colonels closed out one of their most successful seasons in history last week defeating Lebanon Valley 72-67. It was the seventh win in a row for the Wilkesmen who ended the season with a 14-8 record.

Coach Ron Rainey's hoopmen also set a new precedent by recording their third straight winning season, following 12-11 and 13-11 campaigns.

Forward Herb Kemp completed his four year collegiate career in fine fashion as he hauled down his 1000th rebound in the 1969-70 finale. The 6-3 Glenside, Pa. senior finished as the leading rebounder in Colonel history with 1005 rebounds and third on the all-time scoring list with 1286 points.

The leading scorer for the Wilkesmen was 6-0 Junior forward Bill Umbach, who became the tenth entry in the Blue and Gold's 400 point season club by accumulating 406 points (18.5 per game). Umbach had ten 20 plus performances to his credit.

Coach Rainey is looking forward to next season when four of his starting five will be returning. The only graduation losses for the Wilkesmen will be Kemp and reserve center Bob Ockenfuss. Some of the other outstanding returnees beside Umbach are: Rich Davis, 6-5 center, 17.5 scoring average, 218 rebounds; Jay Reimel, 5-10 guard, 216 assists, 136 rebounds; Dave Kurosky, 6-5 forward, 5.5 scoring, 117 rebounds.
