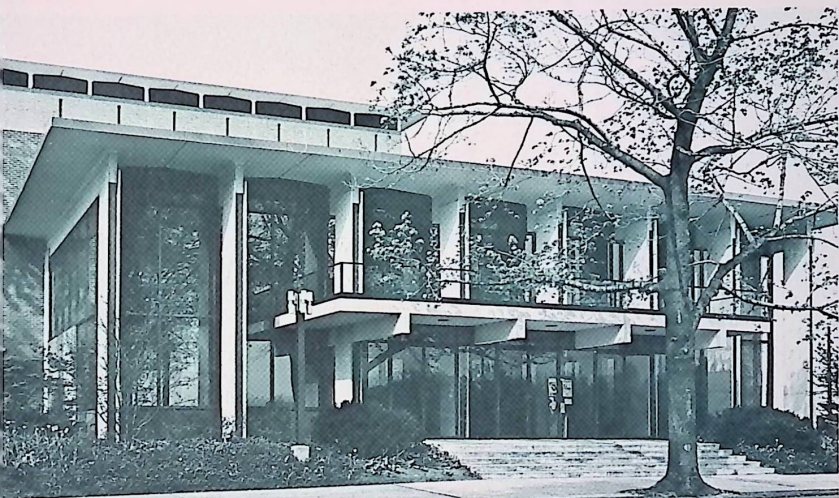

Thy liberty in law!

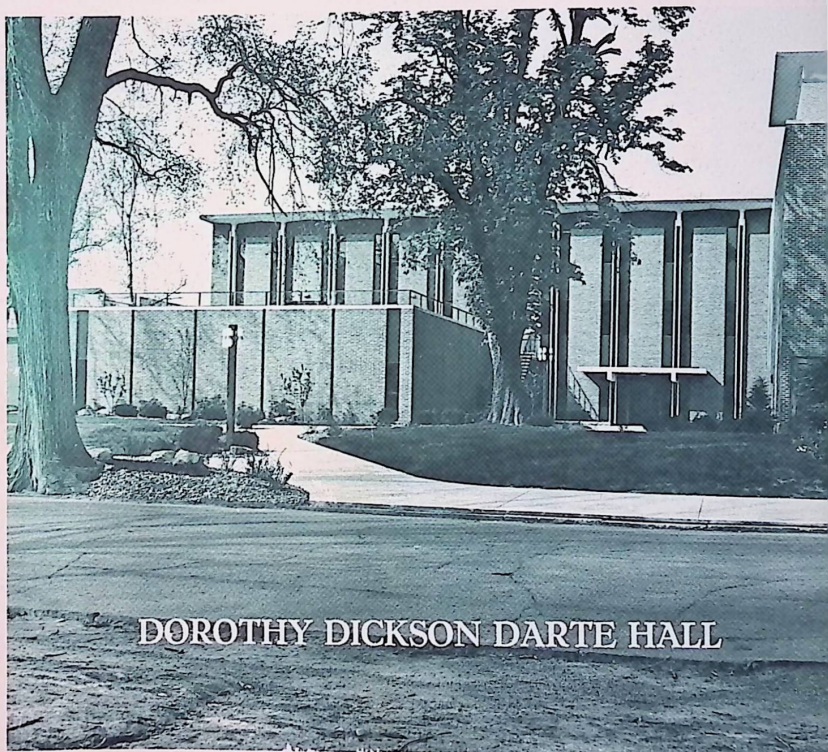

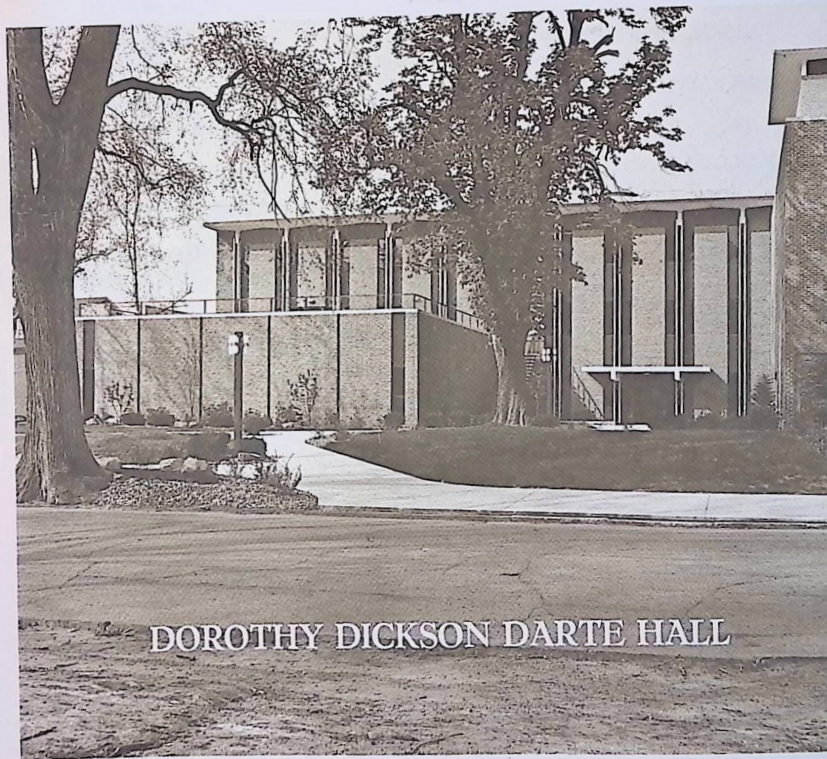
