

The Board of Trustees of Wilkes College purchased the Harding Residence, 141 South Franklin Street, in 1954. Funds for the furnishings of the building were provided by Atty. Gilbert S. McClintock, chairman of the Board, and Marian M. Winsor, granddaughter of Judge Harding. Judge Harding built this home over one hundred and seventy-nine years ago. The Harding Home is a landmark of Wyoming Valley. Harding Hall was first used as a snack bar for students and faculty and then converted to use as the college bookstore. Today it is occupied by the Art Department staff.
