

150 South River Street

The brick structure that stood on this site was built about 1901 on land that had been a part of the property at 146 South River Street. The house is not listed in the 1900 city directory but is clearly visible in a 1902 photograph of South River Street. The property is identified in the 1904 city atlas as belonging to Emily Hillman. The city directories of this period list Arthur Hillman, an attorney who was professionally associated with Andrew H. McClintock, as the head of the household.

Sometime in the mid twentieth century, the house was converted for apartments and the front porch was replaced by a two story addition. Wilkes College purchased the property in 1965.¹ The building, known as "Honor Dorm," was used as a residence hall until demolished in 1973 for the construction of a classroom building.
