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FACULTY ADVISORY GROUP FOR NEW COLLEGIATE ART MUSEUM MEETS AT WILKES

WILKES-BARRE-- The first meeting of the Faculty Advisory Committee for The Collegiate Art Museum in Wilkes-Barre was recently held at Wilkes University.

The committee is reviewing the program profile for the collaborative art museum between Wilkes University and King's College in the former Sterling Annex on South River Street in Wilkes-Barre. Dagit Saylor Architects of Philadelphia, the architects for the project, will use this profile as the floor plans are drawn and spaces designated for various functions such as exhibition areas, meeting rooms, exhibition preparation areas, reading room and offices as well as other facilities.

King's College will use the building for its interdisciplinary arts course, a two semester introduction to the arts required of all undergraduates.

Wilkes University will also use the Museum for teaching purposes and will use one of the galleries for senior and faculty exhibitions for part of the year.

The Collegiate Art Museum in Wilkes-Barre is scheduled to open in early 1992.

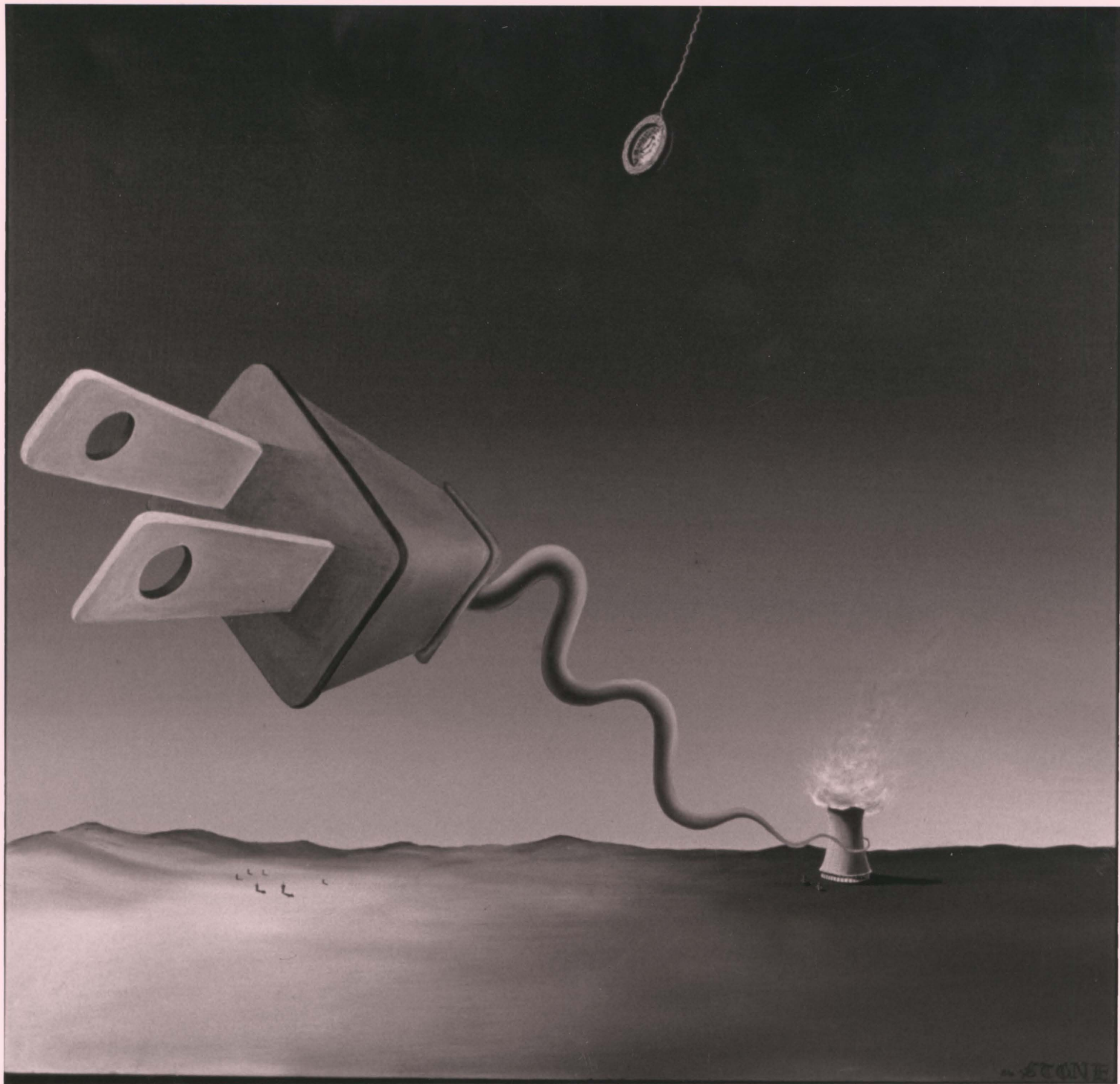
