New Endowed Scholarships

THE MURIEL S. FOLLMER SCHOLARSHIP was established in her memory by husband Dr. Don Follmer '50. First preference will be given to a pre-medical or biology major student demonstrating financial need.

THE KPMG/JOHN R. MILLER SCHOLARSHIP was established by KPMG in 2005 to honor Wilkes Trustee John R. Miller '68 and thank him for his 30 years of service. The scholarship is awarded to an entering freshman, sophomore, junior and senior accounting major student.
