Earlier this week, I worked up a recap of our loan disbursement activity for the two week period which ran from Monday, October 30 thru Sunday, November 12. In closing, I might add that at close of business Sunday, November 12, we had in house, 1,821 Home loan checks totaling \$12,588,883.00, 371 Business loan checks totaling \$6,755,521.00 and 722 Unsecured loan checks totaling \$1,592,741.00. These 2,914 checks total \$20,937,145.00. So you can see with \$20,427,573.00 disbursed in the last two weeks and with \$20,937,145.00 in checks in house to be disbursed things have been happening within our operation. In fact it gladdens the heart of an indigent government lawyer from Oklahoma to see it happen.
