On November 28, we made a home visit to Mrs. Boyer, at which time she informed us that she had again written to you, stating that Family Service had failed to provide the help she requested.

Apparently, Mrs. Boyer had misunderstood our suggestion that she herself should get in contact with Legal Aid or Lawyer Referral Service. She is reconsidering this suggestion and will get in contact with Family Service once she had taken these steps.

Mrs. Boyer mentioned that if no progress can be made through these services, she would adapt to her situation by using gas light and a wood burning stove.

We expect to remain in contact with Mrs. Boyer until we feel that her needs have been adequately met.
