We will be honored by having as our speaker Judge Max Rosen of the United States Court of Appeals. Judge Rosen has been chairman of the Flood Recovery Task Force and will discuss that organization's visit to Biloxi, Mississippi, to view their recovery efforts in that city after Hurricane Camille, which should be of great interest to all of us living in the Wyoming Valley.

LAST WEEK'S PROGRAM:

District Governor Joe Ritts(our immediate Past-President) paid his official visit and was our speaker. He spoke on the theme "Let's Take a New Look". This is the Rotary theme for the year. Governor stated that its meaning is that all Rotarians should take a "new look" at both the Club and themselves. We should, in the first instance, become better acquainted with members of the Club. Further than that, there is a need for new ideas and new programs. He cited the example of Roy Stouffer, a Rotarian who, in the 1940's developed the idea of industrial development in Northeastern Pennsylvania, which has been of great benefit to this area. Governor Joe became a member of Rotary as a result of being a Plant Manager of a plant built under this plan in the Pittston area. He cited as some needed programs Rotaract and Interact Clubs. He closed with a challenge to us -- "Let's take a new look and act".

In addition, prior to Governor Joe's speech, Frank Loch (on behalf of the Rotary Club) presented to Mr. Robert Gloman of the Crippled Children's Association a check in the amount of \$2,500.00.
