The Public Square, Wilkes-Barre, about 1830; drawn from memory in 1866 by C. I. A. Chapman, Esq. Looking through the Square from West Market Street are: at extreme left, the Academy, formerly the Court House building; left fore, town pump and market house; Old Ship Zion, a union church of Methodists and Presbyterians, built about 1812; steepled building beyond, the Court House, completed in 1804. The stage coach is entering South Main Street.
