



## PROSPECT AND SPRING HOUSES, Wyoming Valley, Pennsylvania

The Mountain Houses are located in the centre of the Valley of Wyoming, on the mountain East of Wilkes-Barre, two miles from the town, and one thousand feet above the level of the Valley. The view from the Observatory, on the top of the house, is generally admitted to be one of the finest in the United States. For invalids and others, this locality is unsurpassed, the pure mountain air rendering it remarkably healthy. The far-famed Prospect Rock is immediately adjoining the house, from whose hoary summit may be obtained an unobstructed view of the entire Wyoming Valley, eighteen miles in length, with the Susquehanna River, dotted with islands, winding through its midst and the blue peaks of the Alleghenies in the distance.

The subscriber has refitted and refurnished the Mountain Houses, and will spare no pains to make this a first class Hotel and Summer Resort. The drives and walks in the vicinity are unsurpassed for pleasant beauty. Carriages always in attendance, and visitors by sending word, will be called for by the carriages of the establishment.
