few copies printed. Brilliant impression
from the copperplate.

Shows Roads, in large number, includ-
ing those of the s.w. area. Much detail, for
the time, in the west; probably as much as
in the larger Map.

Counties are bounded, and include those
created in 1789--Mifflin & Delaware (no
others until Apr. 1795).

The large Howell Map was issued 1791
& 1792, and in a large reduction, Trench-
ard sc., 1791 & 1792. Of these only one
copy, of the last noted, was located by Ev-
ans. THIS IS THEREFORE THE EARLIEST
AMERICAN ISSUE LIKELY TO BE
OFFERED.
