

LEHIGH VALLEY COAL CO. MORTGAGE FOR
15 MILLION DOLLARS, AND LAND INDEX
SHOWING TRUST ESTATES WHICH WERE
MORTGAGED

Indenture, dated the first day of February, in the year one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four, between THE LEHIGH VALLEY COAL COMPANY, a corporation created by and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (hereinafter called the "Company" or the "Coal Company"), party of the first part, and PHILADELPHIA TRUST COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and having its principal office and place of business at 415 Chestnut Street, in the City of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania, (hereinafter called the Trustee), party of the second part.

WHEREAS, the Coal Company owns, leases and operates various coal mines and other properties in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms and provisions of a Final Decree entered on November 7, 1923, in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, in the case of United States *vs.* Lehigh Valley Railroad Company, *et al.*, to which case the Coal Company was a party defendant, the Coal Company has agreed to pay to the Lehigh Valley Railroad Company, in full settlement and satisfaction of an indebtedness on account of advances for capital expenditures and otherwise in the past, the proceeds from the sale of \$15,000,000 face value of its Five Per Cent. First and Refunding Mortgage Sinking Fund Gold Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Coal Company has determined to create an appropriate mortgage and to provide for the issuing of bonds thereunder for the following purposes, namely:

- (a) to pay the aforesaid indebtedness to the Lehigh Valley Railroad Company;

and to any and all leases or leasehold interests in coal and mining lands hereafter secured by the Coal Company from and out of the proceeds of bonds issued under this Indenture, and also in and to all those certain coal properties, coal or mining lands, leases of coal or mining lands or leasehold interests in collieries, coal or mining lands, coal properties, buildings, fixtures, machinery, equipment or other property thereon, to the Coal Company belonging and thereto appertaining, hereinafter referred to by name, containing in the aggregate approximately 5145.63 acres of coal land and 2042.85 acres of barren land, and located in the Counties of Luzerne, Schuylkill and Northumberland, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and received or secured by the Coal Company under the leases or assignments of leases or other deeds and articles of agreement from the lessors, assignors or grantors, on the dates specified and recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for the proper Counties in the deed books and pages set forth by full and distinct reference in the following "Schedule of Leases", viz:
