To # Bloomsburg Iron Co. for the amount of Twenty
Penna. Coal Co. # Two Thousand Dollars (\$22000.00) conveyed the
Following parcels of land to the Penna. Coal
Co. with the coal and minerals.

First- Land in Pittston Twp. bounded and described as follows to
wit:- Beginning at a post on the Western side of the North Branch Canal
and towing path in the line of Lot No.5: Thence along said line South
sixty one degrees(old course)East forty and five tenths perches to a
red oak tree: Thence across Lot No.6, North seventeen degrees and thirty
minutes East fifteen perches to a post: Thence North forty seven degrees
forty five minutes East sixty four perches to a post in the line of the
two shares set off to Wm. R. Griffith: Thence by said line North fifty
eight degrees and forty five minutes West forty seven perches across
the Canal to a post on the western side of the towing path ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~
~~XXXXXX~~Thence along the towing path of said Canal, South thirty eight de-
grees West twenty five and five tenths perches to a post: And thence ~~XX~~
South thirty six degrees West fifty two perches to the place of begin-
