I, ALICE LENORE SAYLOR, of the City of Delavan, County of Walworth and State of Wisconsin, being of sound mind and memory, do make, publish and declare this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills, bequests and devises by me made.

FIRST. It is my will that all my just debts, funeral expenses and all charges be paid as soon as practicable after my demise.

SECOND. I give and bequeath to Mrs. Mary Tuttle, of 3845 Stevens Avenue, Minneapolis, Minnesota, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, and silver mentioned in list thereof, and attached hereto.

THIRD. I give and bequeath to Mrs. Anna Gregg, of Delavan, Wisconsin, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars; also sundry household effects mentioned in said list.

FOURTH: I give and bequeath to Donald Meracle, Jr. of Delavan, Wisconsin, the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, for educational purposes.

FIFTH. I give and bequeath to George W. Gressman, of Delavan, Wisconsin, my mercantile building situate in the City of Delavan, Wisconsin, and described as follows, to-wit:

The west nine (9) feet and one (1) inch of lot number five (5), and all of lots numbers six (6) and seven (7), all in Block number eight (8) of the Original Plat of the Village, now City, of Delavan.

SIXTH. I give and bequeath to Ruth Huntington

Crozier, of North Chicago, Illinois, the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars.

SEVENTH. I give and bequeath my Nelson Loose Leaf Encyclopedia and the case containing the same to Ron R. Crozier, of North Chicago, Illinois.

EIGHTH. I give and bequeath to the said Ron C. Crozier and Ruth Huntington Crozier all of my library and books, excepting as bequeathed in paragraph seventh, together with the cases containing the same if they desire them, and it is my wish that any books which they may not desire be given to the Aram Public Library of Delavan, Wisconsin.

NINTH. It is my will that my executor hereinafter named shall give certain articles, being contents of my home in the City of Delavan aforesaid, to the persons, being my friends, according to the list attached hereto,

TENTH. I give and bequeath to the Altar Guild of Christ Church of the City of Delavan, Wisconsin, the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars as a perpetual trust, to be invested in safe interest bearing securities, and the interest therefrom to be used for the purchase of flowers for the altar of said Christ Church in each year on Sundays nearest to August 10th and the Sundays nearest the date of my death, and if any remains over, to be used for the purpose of purchasing flowers for the crypts of myself and my late husband, Harrie S. Saylor, in the Delavan Mausoleum. It is my wish that Mrs. Kate C. Rowe have charge of this as long as she is willing.

ELEVENTH. I give and bequeath to my friend, Mrs. Kate C. Rowe, of Delavan, Wisconsin, the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, and it is my wish that she remain with my body while same is being embalmed, and that the embalming take place in my home, and that I be not taken to any funeral home.

TWELFTH. It is my will and I hereby direct that in the event of my death prior to the year 1940, the promissory note in the sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars executed by Douglas Mc Farlane be cancelled and surrendered to him without payment.

THIRTEENTH. I give and bequeath to Esther E. Marsh, of 2629 Forty-second Avenue Southwest, Seattle, Washington, the dividends accruing from my Standard Oil Company stock for and during her lifetime, and upon her death the said stock shall be given absolutely to Russell Ledwith Marsh, grandson of the said Esther E. Marsh.

FOURTEENTH. I give and devise to my friend and benefactor, Maude Alice Harvey, of Delavan, Wisconsin, my homestead situate in the City of Delavan, County of Walworth and State of Wisconsin, described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land two (2) feet in width east and west, and one hundred thirty-four and three-tenths ($134 \frac{3}{10}$) feet in length north and south off the entire east side of lot number six (6), and all of lot number five (5), excepting and reserving therefrom one (1) rod in width east and west and sixty-three (63) feet in length north and south, off the extreme east side of said lot number five (5), all in Bell's Subdivision, a subdivision of the City of Delavan.

FIFTEENTH. I give and bequeath to the said Maude

SEVENTEENTH. It is my will and I hereby direct that any and all inheritance taxes found to be due upon the bequests and devises herein made, shall be paid from the corpus of my said estate, and not deducted from said bequests and devises.

EIGHTEENTH. All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real, personal and mixed, and wherever situated, I give, devise and bequeath to my executor hereinafter named, in trust, to be invested in safe interest bearing securities and the net income therefrom paid to my friend, Clara B. Hasten of 101 Phila Avenue, West Pittston, Pennsylvania, for and during her natural lifetime. Upon the death of the said Clara B. Hasten, or in case she shall predecease me, then and in such case, the said residue shall be divided equally between Lloyd Marsh, of 5333 Ninth Ave. Northeast, Seattle, Washington, and Adella Hawes Murfin, of Sunnyside, Washington.

NINETEENTH. I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Ray Bowers, of Delavan, Wisconsin, as executor and trustee of this my last will and testament.
