- the Ortelius of Japan (1595): the first edition of the first folio European map of Japan, in original color
- (pictured on card) the Ortelius of Iceland (1595), the "monsters" map, in original color
- excellent, original color copy of the Ortelius of China (1595), the first separate European map of the country
- several other Ortelius maps in original color
- handsome 12" (diameter) terrestrial globe by J. Newton, 1836
- the first separate map of the New World, the 1513 Waldseemüller (see Schwartz, pl. 8, p. 34) in original color
- the Benzoni-De Bry of the Caribbean (1564) - the most beautiful engraved map of the area and shows Columbus' voyages
- the striking and rare Robert Dudley charts (1646) of New England, the Chesapeake Bay, the Southeast, Brazil and other areas
- the Alexander map of New England (1624/25), showing the names of the first landowners in New England (see Schwartz, pl. 54, p. 99)
- c. 1580 Braun & Hogenberg views of Milan & Paris
- van Keulen's c. 1680 chart of New Netherlands and also the first separate map of the Hudson River
- 1776 Sayer & Bennett (Gascoigne) chart of Port Royal and Hilton Head Island
- very attractive 17th century maps of French wine regions
- the spectacular 1767/1775 Ratzer plan of New York City
- the Blaskowitz of Narragansett Bay (1777)
