

THOMAS STEWART appointed power of attorney for the Arthur Erwin heirs. He being an heir and for the children under age.

Recorded - Northampton County Deed Book E-2, page 8, 1797.

(This is in part of record in Deed Book E-2, page 8.)

Power to act for plantation or tracts of land located on Susquehanna River in Luzerne County, late in tenure of Cornelius Nefus and now under agency or management of Thomas Wright, County of Luzerne.

Instrument in writing of or to covenant and execute sometime in year 1789 under the hand and seal of a certain William Stark then of Luzerne County. Conveying or covenanting to convey the said tracts of land to the said Arthur Erwin.

Also mentions said Instrument would be indorsed on back by Thomas Stewart or small piece of paper attached to Instrument.
