House situate in the district aforesaid, known as No.3 or Blanchard

School House so far as the said John Blanchard was interested therein.

To have and to hold the interest of the late John Blanchard, now deceased, in his lifetime, and all the right, title and interest therein

and thereto of the estate of him, the late John Blanchard, deceased unto

the said School Directors, their successors and assigns as agreed to by
