that for ~~THEYEMX~~ and in the consideration of the sum of Three Hundred
and Fifty Dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged: The said Benjamin Cooper doth hereby release, assign, and
set over unto George Cooper, his heirs and assigns forever, all the
right, title and interest in and unto Lot No. 5 in the river tier and
first division of lots in Pittston Township: Bounded Northeasterly by
the lands of John Blanchard: Southerly by the lands of the Pennsylvania
Coal Company: ~~SEWIMEXX~~ Southeasterly, by the lands of William Abbott
and lands of the late Cornelius Cortright: And Northerly by the Sus-
quehanna River. Containing about One Hundred acres of land.

To have and to hold the same unto him the said George Cooper and
his heirs and assigns forever against the said Benjamin Cooper and his
legal representatives, and all persons claiming the same under him
them or any of them: Witness the hand and seal of said Benjamin Cooper
