Trar 12 April 1829

your mother received your letter this day and was much pleased to learn that you had made a new engagement with Mr Shannon - she wishes James to have some Garden made early as she expects to be up about the first week in May. If you think it necessary to have a couple of loads of manure for the garden you will please to get it. the small onions will be found in a box in the cellar. you will please to be particular to have plenty of early Potatoes planted - and let the upper part of the garden to some suitable person to plant with potatoes to the shares -
