Gentlemen:

Under date of October 19th, we addressed a letter to H. K. Fowler, Lloyd's Agents, 86 Beaver St., New York requesting official survey to be made on damage to the above importation and copy of said survey request was sent to you and which you acknowledged under date of Oct. 27th.

We are now glad to say that today we received from Lloyd's Agents the completed survey report from which you will note that the surveyors have agreed with importer as to the amount of the insurance claim as follows:--

Cost of restoration -- -- -- -- \$57.75
plus 33 1/3% depreciation to the piece damaged.

They further state that the sound value of the piece damaged in their opinion is \$1500.

We have paid to Lloyd's Agency, survey fee of \$67.90 and enclose herewith our debit note.

Your kindness in presenting this claim to and collecting from the Insurance Co. with your usual kind attention will be duly appreciated.

When adjusted, if you will send us a draft or credit note, we will, in turn, pay the amount allowed by the Insurance Company to Mr. McClintock. Assuring you of our appreciation, we are,
