Governor:

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 19th inst. Colonel Vinton has honored and will honor all my requisitions for Quartermaster's stores. Immediately upon my return from Albany, I made requisition for all the supplies necessary for five thousand men & have been since receiving and issuing the same. He has clothing & uniforms sufficient for all the present needs of the Department and Camp equipage with the exception of Wall tents, for which he is making provision.

I prepared and submitted to him, an estimate of the clothing, camp & garrison equipage & needed for 28,000 men,

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which he approves and has promised to
provide without delay. I herewith enclose
a copy of the same.

I assure your Excellency, that
nothing in my power will be omitted in
procuring promptly everything necessary
from this Department for the troops
now being raised, and there has been
no trouble thus far, in filling every
requisition which has been received.
