

To the Committee of the Wyoming Claim
Gentlemen

According to request I send you the names
of the surviving heirs of my father, who was one of
the Wyoming Sufferers. My father, Eliphalet Hollett,
lived on Kingston side, near Fort Fort. he owned
a lot when he lived and other lands adjacent, or,
in the neighborhood, in all, to the amount of six
hundred acres. He had seven children, six sons and one
daughter - they are all dead but myself and sister -
my sister's name is Elizabeth Reynolds - she lives
in Cambridge, Franklin County, Vermont, and I live
at York Cross Roads, Sandusky County, Ohio.

My father was killed in the battle fought at Wy-
oming July 3d 1778, and my mother, with a family
of seven small children, after suffering incredible
hardships, succeeded in reaching her friends in Vermont.

All that was my father's was utterly lost to his
widow, or heirs, they never having recovered any
thing for his possessions. I am neighbor to Isaac
Hocum of York, Sandusky Co, O, who is one of the
heirs of the Wyoming Sufferers and with whom
I am well acquainted.
