

Wyoming 15 May 1800

May it Please your Excellency,

Your Order of the 7th April 1780 ^{Sept} Gamelle Hand
I Shall wait your Excellency further Orders
Nothing Material has happened - Since my departure
only the men mentioned in my last being taken
at fighting Creek & Gornie with the Indian
Guns Tomkoks &c. as the first Party did and have
actually brought in two Indian scalps. There
heard of Late Mischief being done on the
West Branch of Snake and on Delaware
but none in this Quarter I have Order from the
Board of War to Engage 30 of the Militia
which I have done for the Defense of this Frontier
Capt Selan the Barrer will hand this to
your Excellency he is a Gentleman of the
free Coor that is stationed at this Post and
has Leave of absence to wait on your Excellency
as he says on Business Respecting the Coor
he expects to return to this Post immediately
