

At a meeting of the Representatives of the Connecticut
claimants from the several Townships in the County of Luzerne
convened at the Court house in Wilkesbarre March 11th 1793.
present Lord Butler, Jesse Fell, Benj^m Carpenter, Nathan Den-
ion, John Franklin, Chester Bingham, Mason Feltner
William Jackson, James Finn, Peter Harris, Christo Hullbut
Gideon Osterhout, Jonah Rogers & Matthias Van Lona --

Resolved by this meeting

1st That an additional sum of Six hundred & thirty dollars
be immediately levied on the Connecticut claimants in this
County, as a fund, for defraying the expense in defending the
suits brought by the Pennsylvania claimants against the
Connecticut claimants; which sum shall be appor-
tioned on the several Townships as follows (viz) Wilkesbarre
shall pay 90 dollars, Kingston 80⁰⁰, Plymouth 70⁰⁰, Hanover 70⁰⁰,
Tioga 70⁰⁰, Pittston 60⁰⁰, Nyalusing Cr. Townshamocks 50⁰⁰,
Newport 24⁰⁰, Exeter 20⁰⁰, Salem 16⁰⁰, & Huntington 20⁰⁰.

2^d That that the representatives of the several Townships, take
suitable measures for apportioning & collecting the sum quoted
on their respective Townships, & that they pay over the same
to the Treasurer of the Connecticut claimants; by the first
day of April next.

3^d That Timothy Pickering, Th^o Franklin & Putnam (at-
tain be appointed Agents for the Connecticut claimants
To represent to the Counsel employed in favour of those
claimants, the facts relative to their ~~own~~ claim; & to
collect evidence necessary to be disproved at their trial in the
circuit

Circuit court at Philadelphia in April next.

4th That the Representatives of the several Townships in this county, cause true Returns of the number of Families & number of Souls in their respective Townships, to be made to one of the agents aforesaid, by the first day of April next.
