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Fassel on Giants: Nothing can be done

It's almost impossible to imagine that it could get any worse, any uglier or any more humiliating for the Giants than the 45-7 shellacking they took in New Orleans on Sunday night.

But then you remember that it was the Saints, who entered the game with a losing record — unlike the Giants' final two opponents of this dreadful season, the Cowboys and Panthers.

Jim Fassel knows this and understands that no matter what he does, he'll still be coaching a team with a feeble offensive line that's charged with protecting an inexperienced quarterback in Jesse Palmer, and a roster that's been decimated by injuries.

"We weren't competitive and that bothers me," Fassel said. "All I can do is go back, retool it and try to be competitive the next week."

He didn't sound optimistic.

"There are no things to turn to," Fassel said yesterday at Giants Stadium. "The guys that are going to be here are here. There isn't anyone that we are going to sign that is going to come in and we'll say, 'He's going to make a difference.' There is nothing that can be done."

Despite the lopsided score, Fassel thought his "undermanned" team played hard in its sixth straight loss.

"It is disheartening," said Fassel, adding that

he won't play Kerry Collins or Jeremy Shockley unless he knows they are sufficiently healthy. "I think they made a good effort. I think a lot of times either because of youth or inexperience we made a lot of mistakes."

That's something that's been a trademark of the losing streak, which has made the strong finishes that became a trademark of his teams become a distant memory.

"You cannot continue to be that good in December," Fassel said. "There are going to be times when you are going to have a meltdown."

This run certainly qualifies as one. The Giants haven't been able to do anything right lately, making any hope of preventing Dallas from clinching a playoff spot against them on Sunday slim.

"I don't think that's paramount in their minds," Fassel said. "We'll work hard and do everything we can to prepare to do the best we can. I don't know what the best we can is."

Fassel said he would talk to Mike Barrow about his language in describing the loss on Sunday night, when the linebacker said, "It felt like we were violated. They held us down and did whatever they wanted."

"Guys say things that I am sure they don't mean or don't want to say it that [way]," Fassel said. "I don't know how he meant it. I am not defending it. But in his mind, he could be saying it and thinking of something else."

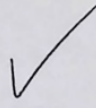

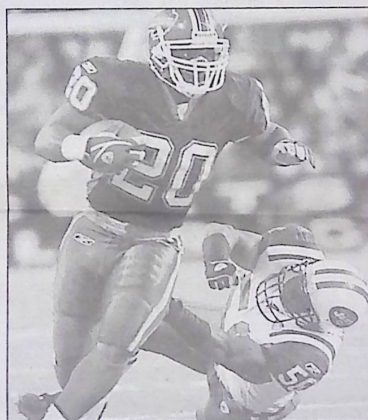
Steelers over Jets: Until Gang Green shows some interest in tackling, Hondo strongly urges you withhold financial backing.

PATRIOTS (-7) over Jags

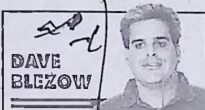

road and won't be thrilled about the low-30s temps and forecasted snow.

COLTS (-7½) over Falcons

BUCS (-10) over Texans

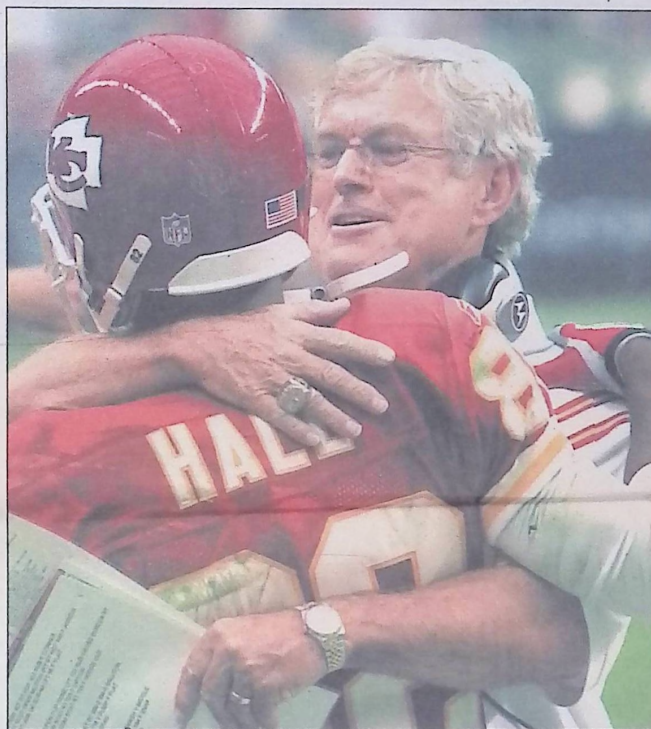

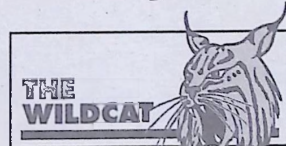
