Know Ye, that, reposing special Trust and Confidence in the Patriotism, Valor, Fidelity, and Abilities of Harold R. Stark, who has been designated as Commander, U. S. Naval Forces in Europe, I have directed, in accordance with the provisions contained in an Act of Congress approved May 22, 1917, that he have the rank of Admiral, from the 1st day of August, 1939.

Done at the city of Washington this 22nd day of June in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-two and in the 166th year of the Independence of the United States.
