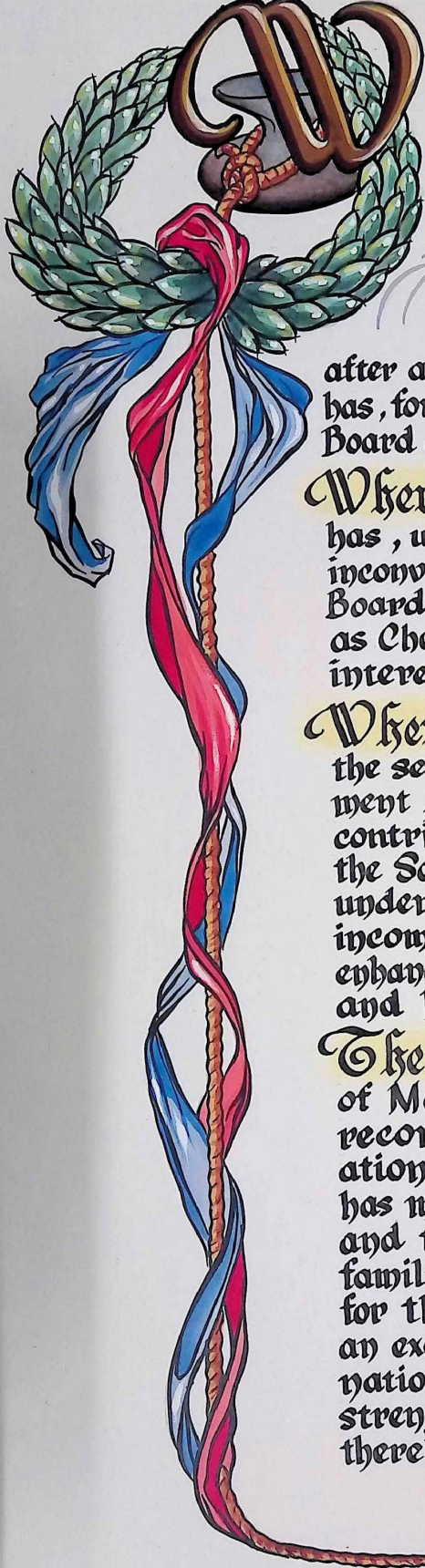




Whereas ,
