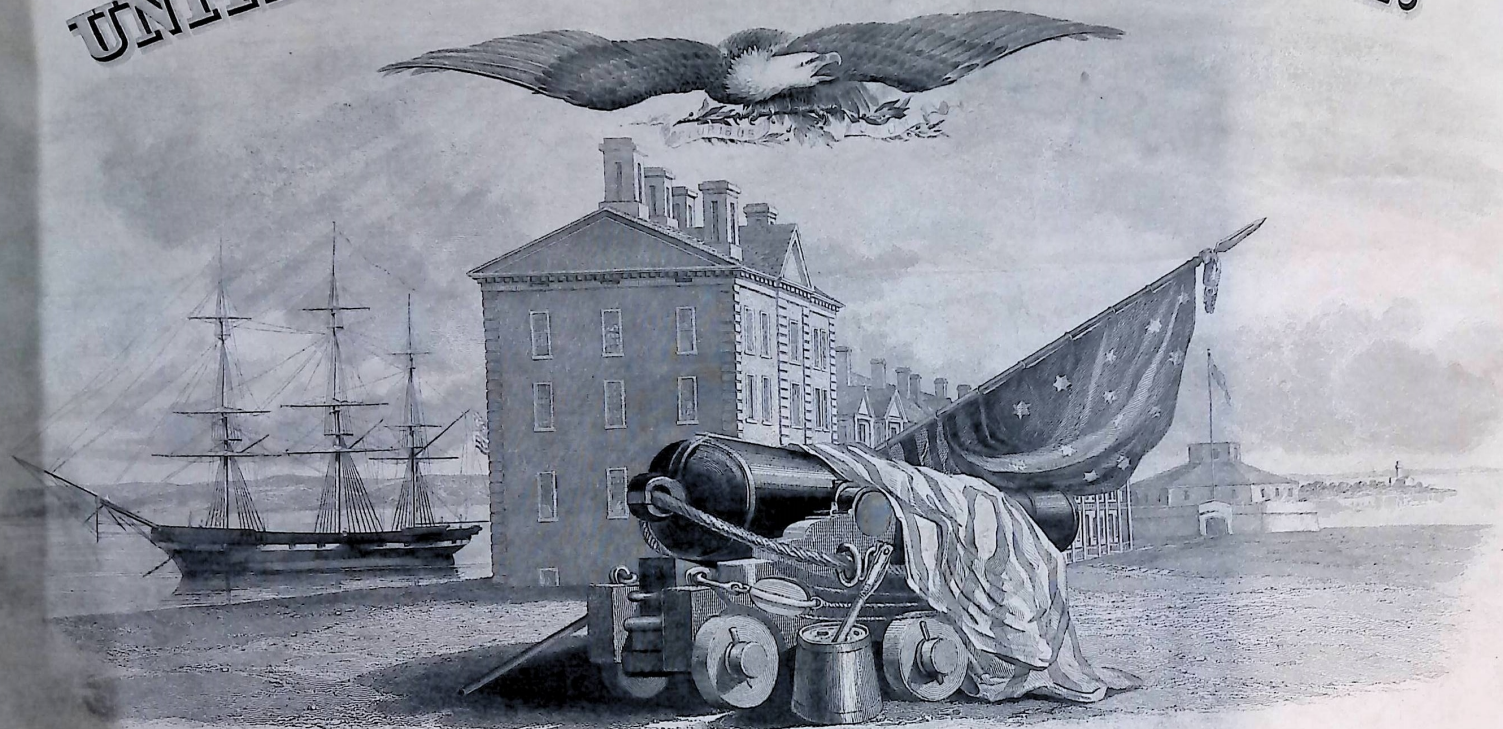

 the Law, grant to him this **Certificate of Graduation**:

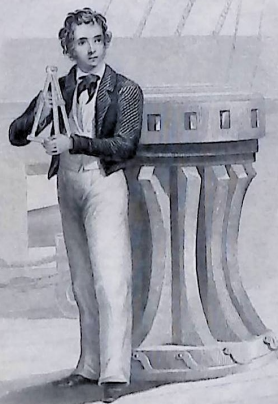
