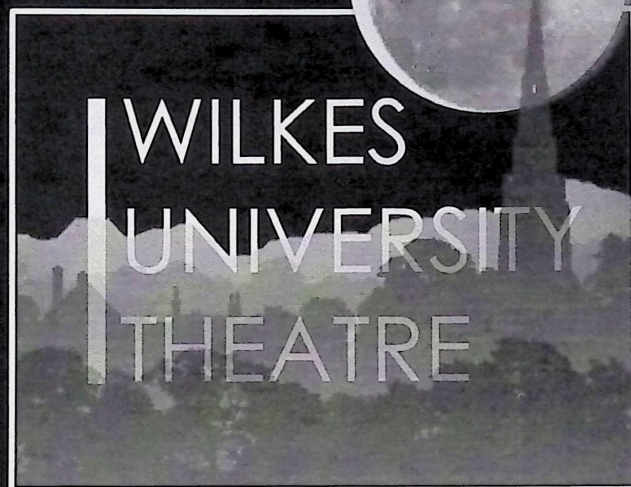

When Thornton Wilder's "Our Town" opened on Broadway February 4, 1938 no one was more surprised by its success than Wilder himself. He did not foresee that the play would win the Pulitzer Prize, or that well into the 21st century, "Our Town" would survive and thrive on and off-Broadway, and in theaters across the United States and around the world.

But 75 years later, people are still watching the play. "Our Town" was borne out of the American experience, yet other countries import it as their own. The play still speaks across cultures, across time zones, across languages. By some accounts it is the most produced American play ever.

No one could mistake the faintly fussy, professorial-looking character for a man of the people. Yet Wilder has written some of the most authentic Americana of his time. He reflected in later years, "Since my play is about everybody, everybody is in my play."

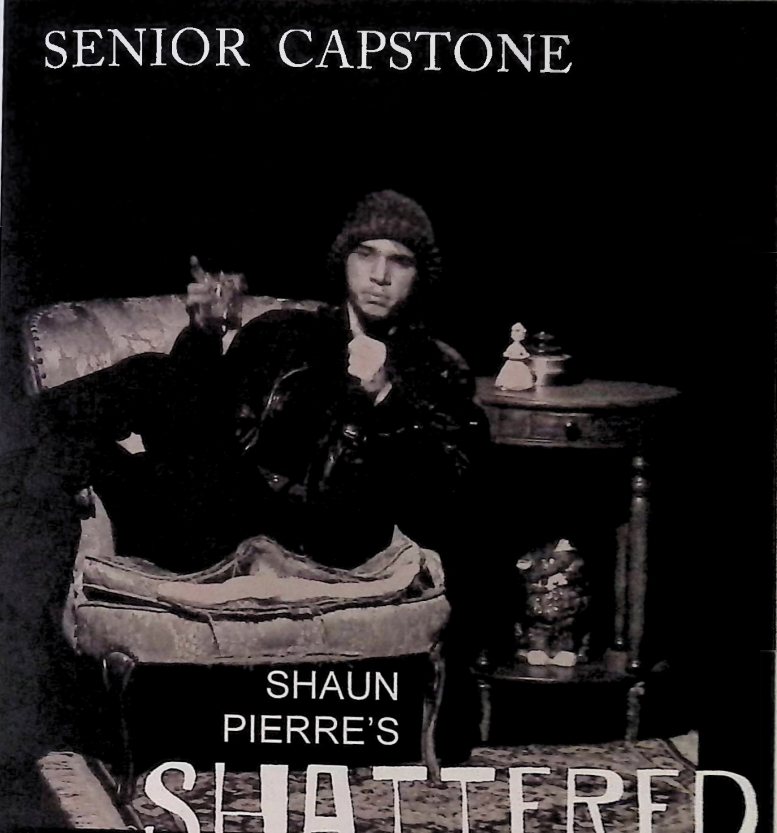

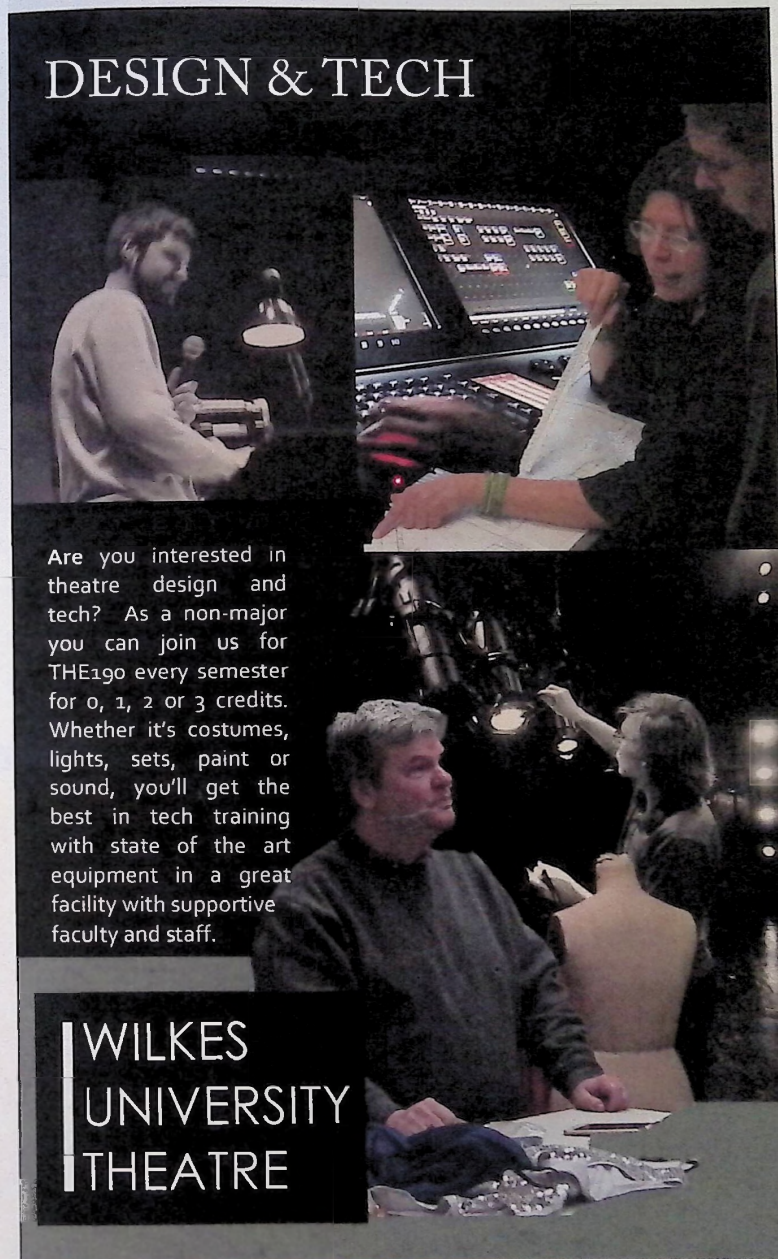

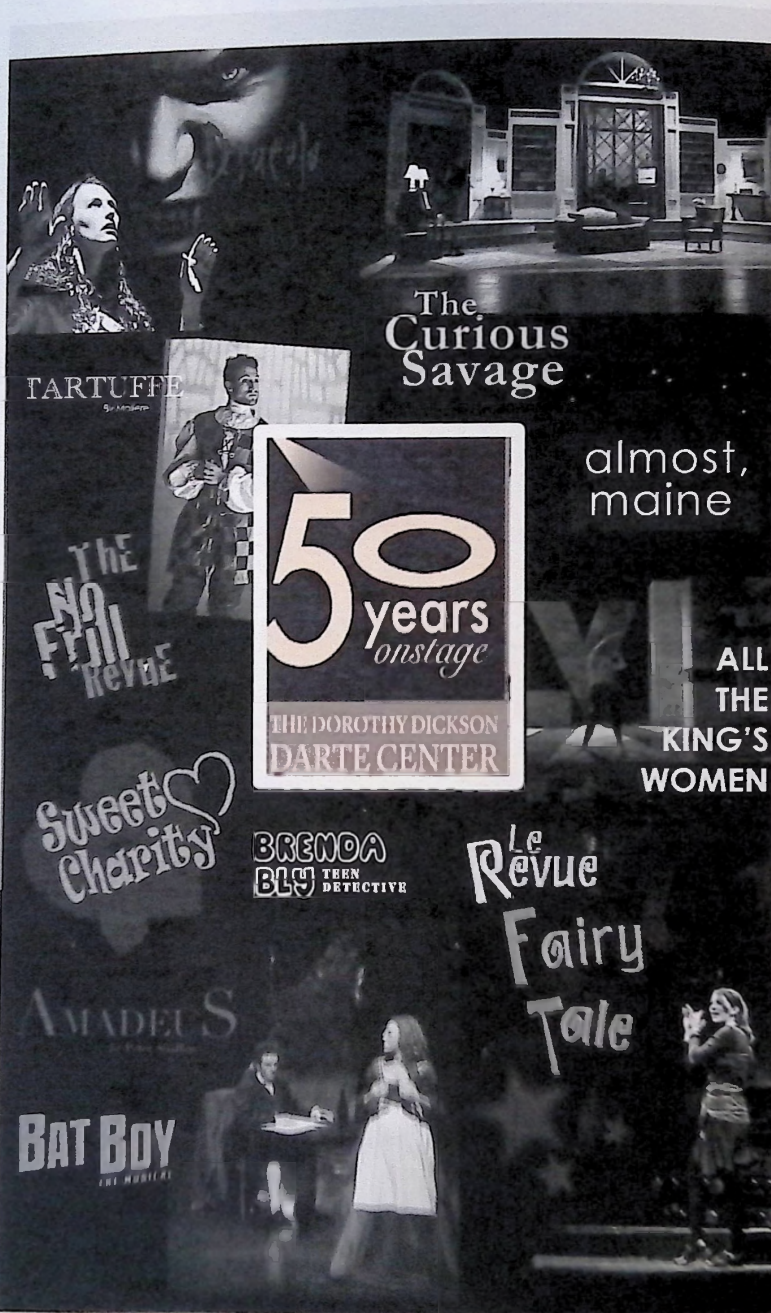
