SOME INTERESTING HIGHLIGHTS CONCERNING OUR CONTRIBUTION TO THE GREATER WILKES-BARRE AREA OVER THE PAST FIFTY NINE YEARS:

1920 — During this year the club helped raise gifts amounting to more than \$6,000, which was distributed to the Shelter and Day Nursery, Home for Friendless Children and the Georgetown Settlement.

1927 - 1928 — Sponsored Dallas Kiwanis Club. Made generous contribution after fire destroyed First Baptist Church in Wilkes-Barre. Accepted quota of \$20,000 in Community Welfare Drive.

1934 — Placed book carts in each hospital. Supported organization of C. C. C. Camps. This was also the fifth year of the Educational Loan Fund and the tenth year of the School Orchestra Contest.

1936 - 1937 — Started Women of Kiwanis. Added \$1,400 to Kiwanis Educational Loan Fund to make a total of \$10,000.00. Sponsored Crippled Boy Scout Troop. Sent donation to Flood Relief of Louisville, Kentucky Kiwanis Club.

1943 — Exceeded War Bond quota of \$25,000 by 162%. Continued sponsorship of 4-H Clubs.

1945 — Sold \$150,000 in War Bonds. Enrolled 42,000 youngsters in Scrap Salvage Drive.

1946 — Organized first Key Club in Wilkes-Barre at Coughlin High School. Since then Wilkes-Barre Kiwanis has organized Key Clubs at G.A.R. and Meyers High Schools.

1950 - 1951 - 1952 — Sponsored three radio auctions, netting a total of \$16,900 for the Children's Ward at Wilkes-Barre General Hospital, Wyoming Valley Hospital and Mercy Hospital.

1954 — Started Kiwanis participation in Red Cross Blood Bank. Our first Wilkes College Play, "Girl Crazy."

1957 — Sponsored three Wilkes College Plays and made a total of \$9,000 of which \$4,700 went to Wilkes College and \$4,300 went to the Boy Scouts.

1958 — Sponsored Wilkes College production of "Witness for the Prosecution" and netted \$5,000. \$3,000 of this was contributed to the Girl Scouts.

1960 - 1961 — Placed 700 litter baskets throughout Wilkes-Barre City. Sponsored Scout Troop at Kes-Lyn.

1962 - 1963 — Chartered first Circle K Club at Wilkes College.

Adopted Wheel Chair Club project formerly carried on by Mrs. Paul Bedford. Organized Pennsylvania State University (Lehman Campus) and King's College Circle K Clubs, making Wilkes-Barre Kiwanis the only club in Kiwanis International sponsoring 3 Key Clubs and 3 Circle K Clubs.

1965 — Contributed \$2,000 to Y.M.C.A. Camp Fund. Presented Gold Wheel Chair to White House with Vice President Hubert Humphrey accepting. Bought 214 Wheel Chairs and 56 Walkers through Wheel Chair Club. In three years, Wheel Chair Club had raised \$40,000.

1966 - 1967 — Theatre Project raised \$4,409 with the following contributions: \$1,500 to the Wheel Chair Club, \$1,020 for camperships at Salvation Army Camp, Boy Scout Camp and the Y.M.C.A. Camp and \$1,400 to the Y.M.C.A. to finish Health Lodge.

1969 - 1970 — Contributed \$1,300 to Camp Kresge for canoes and camperships. Gave \$2,000 to Boy Scouts for Kitchen addition at Camp Acahela. Sent Coughlin High School Band to "Band Day" at Penn State University. Established a special Kiwanis section at King's College Library and Wilkes College Library with a grant of \$2,000 to each College.

1970 - 1971 — Gave \$2,000 to Girl Scouts to purchase table and chairs for their new dining hall. Provided \$585 for concrete tree planters in central Wilkes-Barre. Over 4,000 young people attended our first "Moo-In" bringing the farm to the city. Sent G.A.R. Memorial High School Band to "Band Day" at Penn State University.

1971 - 1972 — Provided \$4,000 for new water front dock at Y.M.C.A. Camp Kresge. Sent Meyers High School Band to "Band Day" at Penn State University.

1974 - 1975 — Continued our many years of support of Summer Camperships with the expenditure of \$1,150. Purchased gas heater for Boy Scout Camp with \$1,453.00. Donated \$1,749.00 to Cerebral Palsy Association for carpets at their headquarters. Supported Meals on Wheels Program with a \$3,000 contribution. Provided large Christmas trees to the three elderly Hi-rise Apartment Buildings in Wilkes-Barre. Purchased and contributed Vocational Guidance Manual series to each of the four Wilkes-Barre High School libraries.

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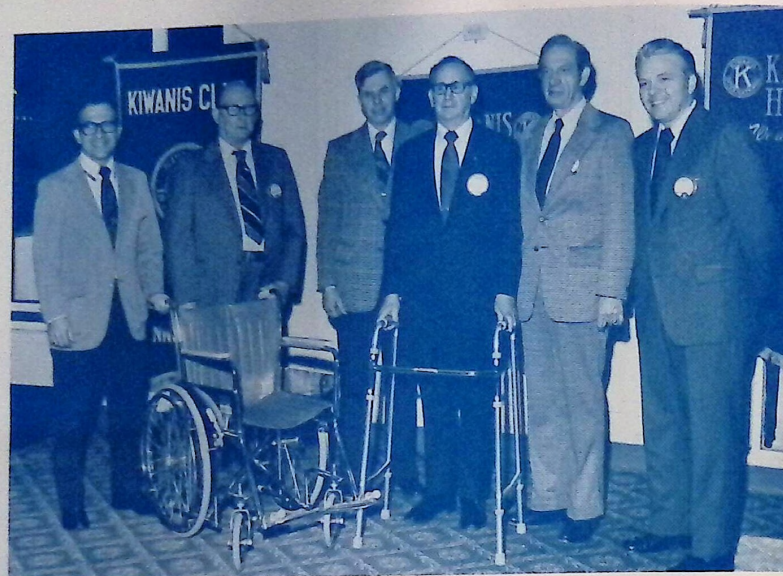

The Kiwanis Wheel Chair Club of Wilkes-Barre was founded in 1935 as "Friends for Shut-Ins" by Mrs. Paul Bedford. During the 1940's its name was changed to Memorial Wheel Chair Club; arrangements were made to ship many chairs overseas in answer to appeals from other countries. Over 40 subsidiary clubs were started with the Memorial Club as "mother club." The Memorial Club distributed over 500 wheel chairs during this period.

In the 1960's Mrs. Bedford sought help from the Wilkes-Barre Kiwanis Club to insure the continuation of her Wheel Chair Club. With the help of Wilkes College, which provides the storage and office facilities for the Wheel Chair Club, Wilkes-Barre Kiwanis assumed this responsibility for the continued operation of the Club. It was in the mid-sixties that the Kiwanis Wheel Chair Club passed the 1,000 mark with almost 700 chairs being shipped overseas and over 300 in continuous circulation in the United States, most of these in the Greater Wilkes-Barre Area. It was in 1963 that the Kiwanis Wheel Chair Club dispatched the largest shipment ever to leave this area, sending 60 chairs to Algeria, Chile, Columbia, Hungary (12 chairs going behind the Iron Curtain), Israel, Turkey, Korea, Hong Kong; and India, six of these chairs staying aboard the S. S. Hope on her third world wide medical mission of mercy.

Over the past 20 years many honors have been bestowed upon Mrs. Bedford and the Kiwanis Wheel Chair Club. In 1956 Mrs. Bedford was named a Distinguished Pennsylvania State Daughter. It was in 1962 that she attended a White

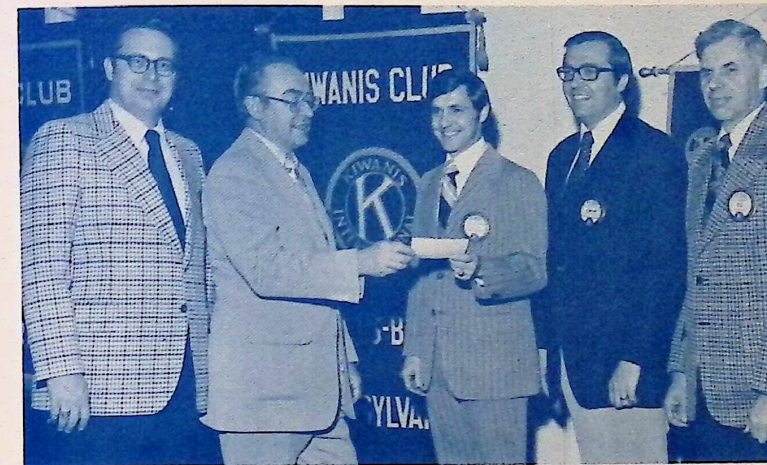
House International luncheon, sponsored by the President's Committee on Employment of the Handicapped. The Dr. Benjamin Rush award was presented to Mrs. Bedford and the Kiwanis Wheel Chair Club in 1963.

Today we have over 100 "Branch" Clubs in operation throughout the world. We invite your consideration for memorial gifts to help continue this most significant and worthy work. \$100.00 purchases a wheel chair which will be inscribed with the name of the donor and persons to be remembered. For those in need - HOW TO GET A WHEEL CHAIR:

Wheel Chairs and Walkers are supplied to people in Wilkes-Barre by the Kiwanis Wheel Chair Club of Wilkes-Barre. The request should be made to Eric R. Planitzer, Secretary, 38 Durkee Street, Forty Fort, Pennsylvania 18704, Phone 287-3447. He will supply an application which must be completed and returned to the Secretary. It takes about three days to provide the equipment which the applicant must pick up and return.

Wheel Chairs and Walkers are supplied to people in other areas through the local "Branch" Wheel Chair Club in that area. Applications will be referred to the Wheel Chair Club serving the area where the applicant lives.

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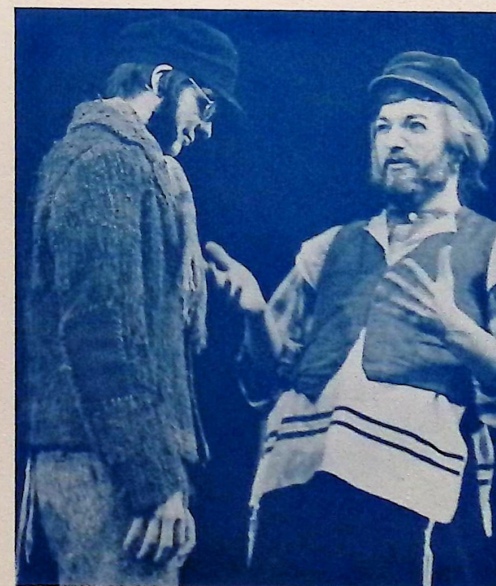

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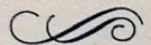

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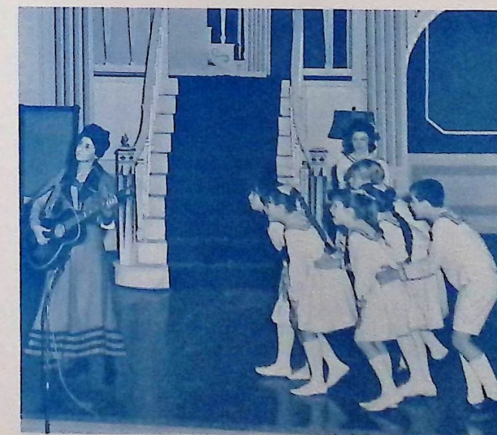
